Women are proving to be better borrowers: Data

New Delhi: Women are proving to be better borrowers since they display higher credit consciousness and better credit scores, compared to their male counterparts, a study by TransUnion CIBIL revealed.

As of 2021, 53% of the 54 million women borrowers had a CIBIL score in the prime category (with credit scores of 731-770) and above compared to 47% for men.

The delinquency rate for women borrowers was pegged at 5.2% across retail credit products, compared to 6.9% for their male counterparts. Besides, the report pointed out that women borrowers were increasing at a faster pace in recent years—29% annually.

They accounted for 29% of the borrowers, compared with a quarter of the borrowers in 2016.

Military talks with China on March 11

New Delhi: India will hold the next round of top-level military talks with China on March 11 in yet another bid to ease the 22-month long troop confrontation in eastern Ladakh, after the last such dialogue in January failed to break the deadlock in the high altitude region with rival troops amassed against each other.

India hopes for "some forward movement" in at least completing the stalled troop disengagement at Patrolling Point-45 (PP-45) in the Hot Springs-Cogma-Kongka La area in the 10th round of the corps commander-level talks to be held on the Indian side of the Chushul Molo border point on Friday. The People's Liberation Army (PLA), however, has so far rebuffed all proposals by India to de-escalate the much bigger standoff at the Chinese-occupied Ningtang Nalan (CNS) track junction and Depsang Plains.

SC seeks study of Bihar booze ban

New Delhi: As prohibition law in Bihar resulted in lower courts and Patna High Court were flooded with cases pertaining to bail and prosecution under the Act and with two third of judicial time being spent in handling them, the Supreme Court asked the state government to place before it social and legislative impact assessment of the law and also expressed concern that government is not taking preventive measures to stay violation of the law which is being done by complicity of officials.

A bench of Justices Sanjay Kishan Kaul and M J Sreedhara directed the Bihar government to collect data on number of prosecutions under the Act and cases pending in different courts including the HC

Why can't Rao get permanent bail, HC to NIA

Mumbai: The Bombay high court on Tuesday issued notice to the National Investigation Agency (NIA) and sought its reply in two weeks to a petition by Egan Varvara Rao seeking permanent bail.

The HC wants NIA's stand on why it never challenged an interim bail granted last February which thus attained finality.

The 32-year-old poet-activist from Hyderabad was arrested in 2018. "His age has further advanced," said the high court and referred to an earlier order that said there are no facilities in Taloja jail. Varvara Rao was granted interim bail of six months on health grounds by the HC on September 22, 2020. Since then, it extended his time to return to prison several times. Senior counsel Anand Gopal, a lawyer for Justice S B Shukre and G A Sanap on Tuesday, said that Rao is suffering from early Parkinson's, a degenerative disease.

Gen SF RODRIGUES, PWSM, VSM, ADC (RETIRED), EX COAS

(19 September 1935 to 04 March 2022)

With utmost grief and deep sense of loss, we share the sad news of the untimely demise of Gen SF Rodrigues, PWSM, VSM, ADC (Retired) on 04 March 2022 at his native place, Goa.

The officer was commissioned into Regiment of Artillery on 18 Dec 1952 and commanded a Medium Regiment in a main of independent spirit; the office took part in the Indo-Pak War of 1971 and later commanded a Mountain Brigade, an Infantry Division and a Corps in the Northern Sector. He was the 'Goa Chief' of Army Staff, when the Indian Peace Keeping Force was deployed in Jaffna, Sri Lanka during Operation PAWAN. Thereafter, he served as the GOC-in-C Central Command and later as the GOC-in-C Western Command. The officer was appointed as the Hony ADC to the President of India in 1987, and was decorated with the Param Vir Chakra Medal in 1986. He took over as the Co Chief of Army Staff on 30 June 1990, and retired from service on 30 June 1993, after 41 years of distinguished service.

Gen SF Rodrigues (Retired) was widely known as a strategist and a visionary leader. After retirement, he engaged himself in social and literary pursuits and delivered numerous talks on strategic issues. He was appointed as the Governor of Punjab on 09 Nov 2004.

His passing away has left an irreplaceable void in the Gunner fraternity. He is survived by his wife Mrs Jean Rodrigues, sons Capt Neale Rodrigues (Merchant Navy), Dr Mark Rodrigues and daughter Susan Viswanathan.

All ranks of the "Regiment of Artillery" convey their heartfelt condolences and wish the God Almighty to bless the bereaved family strength and courage to bear the irreparable loss. May God rest the departed soul in peace.
