CHANGE Begins Here

hether it's braving the harsh winter or battling torrential rain, wading through knee-deep water to rescue stranded souls or delivering meals to the hungry, Robinhood Army (RHA), a group of good Samaritans, goes that extra mile and even beyond to help the needy. Driven by passion and a deep sense of responsibility, this non-profit, volunteer-based group embodies heroism and social responsibility in its purest forms.

Neel Ghosh, founder, RHA, said the non-profit's name came from the Robinhood legend. "Folklore describes Robinhood as the hero who stole wealth from the rich and distributed it to the poor. Idea behind RHA is based on a similar premise, though we don't take money from anyone, but resources and services from those ready to give and stand by those in need," said Ghosh.

Over the years, RHA, which has completed a decade of service, has taken on new roles, from helping the elderly with medicine deliveries to enrolling slum children into schools, growing beyond its initial mission. It organised plasma donation drives, helped people with disabilities find jobs, and even acted as saviours during natural disasters.

RHA was inspired by Refood International, an organisation based in Portugal. which collects excess food and gives it to the hungry. Ghosh. who was then working for Zomato in Portugal, came to work with Refood and thought the concept would be a great way to help those in need in India. "When I first stepped out

India, it felt like I had stepped out of my comfort zone and realised two things: The sheer scale of the need to feed the hungry, and the fulfilment that goes with it," Ghosh said.

While Covid-19 was a moment of reckoning for many, for RHA, it was a defining chapter in their tale. What began as a grassroots movement to feed the hungry transformed into a nationwide lifeline, with volunteers coming together to serve a society in crisis. Covid-19 was

The Robin couldn't afford bus fare, but showed up every time. RHA has grown into a global movement with esence in 406 cities worldwide, serving 141 million meals annually to those in need, all without a single rupee of

funding from outside. In Delhi alone, it has more than 10,000 active Robins. However Ghosh insists RHA's mission goes beyond delivering

Attacker caught by Chennai hosp staff while trying to flee

This happened amid growing demands by doctors across India for better protection and legal safeguards against violence, especially after the rape-murder of a resident doctor in Kolkata's RG Kar Medical College on Aug 9.

Jaganathan's attacker, identified as M Vignesh, was caught by hospital staff while attempting to flee. The automobile engineering diploma-holder was later remanded in judicial custody.

Police said his mother Prema Manoharan was an advanced-stage cancer patient who had received six rounds of chemotherapy and palliative care at the hospital. Her condition worsened at home three days ago.

According to Parthasarathy, the attacker had visited the hospital a day before the attack, where he quarrelled with oncologist Jaganathan.

On Wednesday, Vignesh took an outpatient slip, waited for his turn and once inside the doc-

locked the door and launched a vicious attack with a kitchen knife. He discarded the bloodstained knife on the hospital premises and attempted to escape. Opposition parties con-

demned the assault, while criticising the DMK-led govt's handling of law and order in the state and its "failure" in protecting doctors in medical facilities. In response, deputy

CM Udhayanidhi Stalin visited the hospital and assured its staff and the medical community that the govt would take stringent action against the at-

Chennai police commissioner A Arun also visited the hospital and announced that security would be increased.

State health minister Ma Subramanian reaffirmed the govt's commitment to safety, noting recent measures to improve hospital security such as the installation of CCTV cameras at over 2,000 primary health centres across Tamil Nadu in recent months.
