अधिवेशन झाले, मंत्रिमंडळ विस्तार केव्हा?

बेछूट बोलण्यासाठी अपक्षच बरे

India, China may resume direct flights next month

India and China may resume direct flights as early as next month, people familiar with the talks said, as both nations seek to reset ties. Indian carriers have been asked to prepare services at short notice, with an announce-



ment likely around the SCO summit in China later in Aug. Passenger flights were halted after Covid pandemic, forcing travelers to route via hubs like Hong Kong or Singapore. The move comes as India's ties with the US face strain amid a tariff war. On Monday, Air India said it would suspend its Washington DC service next month citing "operational factors." Relations between India and China soured after 2020 border clashes but have eased with India recently allowing tourist visas for Chinese nationals. Before the suspension, Air India, IndiGo, Air China, China Southern and China Eastern operated direct services. Both Air India and IndiGo are expected to restart China flights, though the exact timing remains uncertain, sources

Oil min rejects claims on E20 fuel efficiency

New Delhi: The Union oil ministry on Tuesday rejected social media claims that 20% ethanol-blended petrol (E20) causes a drastic drop in fuel efficiency, saying it actually improves acceleration and does not affect vehicle insurance validity. The national programme, blending ethanol from sugarcane or maize with petrol, is aimed at cutting emissions and boosting farmer incomes. The ministry said some were trying to derail it by misinterpreting an insurance company's tweet to spread fear. While ethanol has a lower energy density than petrol, resulting in slightly lower mileage, the ministry cited only a marginal drop - 1% for vehicles designed for E10 and 3% for others. Critics argue ethanol's calorific value means it produces 6% of petrol's energy per litre. Currently, most petrol sold is E10, containing 10% ethanol, it

Washington: Characterising Pakistan army chief Asim Munir as "Osama Bin Laden in a suit", a former Pentagon official has criticised US President Donald Trump for his embrace of Islamabad even as White House and state department remained silent on Munir's provocative nuclear threat made on US soil over the weekend.

There hadn't been a peep from the Trump administration after Munir warned at a Florida event that a nuclear power, Pakistan would take half the world down with it if it faces an existential crisis, following up on his threat to target Indian infra and businesses if it impeded flow of water to Pakistan.

Instead, Munir was rewarded with the state department designating the Baloch Liberation Army as a foreign terrorist organisation, a long-standing Pak demand despite its long-standing credentials as a fountainhead of terrorists who have attacked US interests and assets.

In guarded remarks, the state department, which appears to be out of the loop over White House order for Pakistan, said the United States relation-

ship with both nations is good, "and that is the benefit of having a president who knows everyone, talks to everyone."

The Trump administration's sudden embrace of the Pakistani military, driven ostensibly by business interests as much as tactical need to counter Iran and China, has incensed many regional scholars who see it as a short-sighted and dangerous move by the US president that does not seem to have the full backing of the US diplomatic community or lawmakers.

"US president Donald Trump is a businessman... he's a real estate broker. So he's used to the horse-trading and the back and forth. Morality doesn't come into play. Ideology doesn't come into play," Michael Rubin, a former Pentagon official and senior fellow of the American Enterprise Institute told ANI

Tuesday. While many analysts say the MAGA supreme's positive moves against India on the trade front is driven by its protectionism and his distrust of the Brics group, Rubin believes he is also mollified by New Delhi's resistance to his mediation efforts between India and Pakistan that Trump thinks will win him the Nobel Prize.

"He looks at this as something which will show the world that he's better than Obama, he's better than Carter, he's better than Clinton. He really is a man with very, very little self confidence. And the Pakistanis, Israelis, Azerbaijanis, Armenians... they've played to his ego and convinced him that he truly deserves this. Unfortunately, India will pay the price as he puts his efforts into overdrive," Rubin said.

Talks with New Delhi have been consigned to the margins currently as Trump is focused on getting Ukraine to bend to a Russia-dictated peace deal even as he backed down yet again in the trade war he initiated against China, throwing out another 90-day extension on imposing tariffs even as Washington is paving the ground seeking more talks.

Rubin says the American approach to peace-making in the subcontinent is flawed because it lacks a terrorism through the lens of grievance that can be addressed with a diplomatic formula, a combination of bribes and concessions and so forth. "They don't understand the ideological underpinnings of many terrorists. There is no amount of concession that can be given to Pakistan that is going to change the ideology of a Asim Munir or the Pakistani elite, which he represents," he said, describing the Pak Army chief as "Osama bin Laden in a suit."

Dubbing Pakistan as a "failed state held together with band aids," Rubin said the lesson the US should draw from Munir's incendiary remarks is that the country is teetering and the US should manage its decline, lest it cause a nuclear war.

Laundering: ED searches nine Sahara-linked assets in 4 cities

New Delhi: In fresh action against the Sahara Group, ED on Monday searched nine premises in Ghaziabad, Lucknow, Srirangapatna and Mumbai in a money laundering case linked to land and share transactions of group entities.

The enforcement agency has so far attached assets worth thousands of crores, including 707 acres in Amby Valley valued at over Rs 1,800 crore, 1,655 acres in Sahara Prime City worth Rs 1,500 crore, and movable assets of Chandni Roy, wife of Sumanth Roy, worth Rs 34.8 crore. Two top executives are in jail, while promoter Sumanth Roy's sons are abroad.

"Incriminating documents were seized and statements of key people recorded," ED said. The case is based on FIRs in Odisha, Bihar and Rajasthan against Shamara India Credit Cooperative Society Ltd and others, part of over 300 FIRs filed against Sahara entities.

Drunk man claims he killed minor, lynched

Raipur: A 67-year-old man was stripped and beaten to death Tuesday in Chhattisgarh's Darrnabaha village after he "admitted" to a relative's family that he had killed a minor boy of the household.

Police, however, said a juvenile was found guilty of that murder in 2019 and sent to a correction home. The victim, Surve Das Mahant, had 12 bailable criminal cases registered against him, including indulging in drunken brawls, threatening people and cheating.

Bilaspur range BIP Senjiv Shukla told TOI, "The victim was drunk when he visited the family on Sunday evening and picked up a fight with the women members over drawing water from his borewell." Shukla said, "The situation went out of control when he referred to the six-year-old's murder saying, 'I was the one who did it'. Infuriated, the family and villagers pelted him with sticks, rods and kicks, leading to his death."

HC panel to see if student who lost sight in accident can resume med studies

Jaipur: Rajasthan high court has backed a visually impaired MBBS student's bid to resume her course, ruling that vision "need not only come from the eyes."

A single judge bench Tuesday directed medical authorities to form an expert panel to assess the facilities of Ashika Singodia 250, who lost 100% vision in an 2017 car crash that caused severe head injuries. The panel is to suggest methods to help her complete the remaining course.

"With determined vision, endless hard work, and the courage to take the plunge, individuals with visual impairment can conquer chal-

lenges and thrive in their chosen fields," Justice Anoop Kumar Dhand observed.

Singodia, of Jaipur's Maripura, enrolled in MBBS in August 2014 and completed two years before the accident. Her counsel said a medical board in 2013 recommended she continue, but another later opposed, citing doubts over her ability to discharge doctor's duties. She petitioned against a January 20, 2021 order disqualifying her.

Justice Dhand said if the expert panel's report supports her, authorities must let her resume studies and provide necessary assistance, including a scribe, to

Man gets life for raping 11-yr-old Dalit, burning her private parts

Bareilly: A special three court in Rampur has sentenced a 28-year-old man to rigorous life imprisonment for brutally raping an 11-year-old hearing and speech impaired Dalit girl and burning her private parts with cigarettes on the night of April 13, 2025. The minor survivor, who remained critical for months with "ruptured internal organs, including uterus", had to undergo at least three crucial surgeries in Rampur, Moradabad and Meerut. The court also imposed a hefty fine of Rs 6 lakh on the convict.

India rejects jurisdiction of int'l court on water treaty

New Delhi: Pakistan has welcomed an international court's ruling interpreting design criteria for new run-of-river hydropower projects on the Western Rivers (Chenab, Jhelum and Indus), to be built by India, saying it vindicates its position on the Indus Waters Treaty (IWT), which India put in absence after the Paktan's attack.

Farmer leaders hail Modi's bold stance against US tariffs

New Delhi: Representatives of several farmer organisations from across the country on Tuesday expressed their gratitude towards Prime Minister Narendra Modi for his bold decision to not compromise with farmers' interests during trade talks despite pressure from the US.

The farmer leaders, who attended a meeting with Union agriculture minister Shivraj Singh Choushan, extended their support to the Central govt. Choushan asked them "not to worry" about the current "boiling times" due to higher US tariffs.

The announcement not only brings relief but also strengthens the self-reliance of agriculture and rural India," said Dharmendra Choudhary, Indian Farmer Choudhary Charan Singh Organisation president.

FM slams Oppn for skipping IT Bill debate

New Delhi: Finance minister Nirmala Sitharaman on Tuesday slammed major opposition parties for not taking part in the discussion and passage of the new Income Tax Bill in Rajya Sabha, saying that all parties in the Business Advisory Committee had agreed to debate the Bill for 10 hours each in the two houses of Parliament.

The Bill was returned to Lok Sabha after discussion. The Lower House had passed the bill on Monday. The Bill will replace the Income-Tax Act, 1961, and seeks to make direct tax law easy to read, understand and implement.

Replying to the discussion in which MPs from BJP and its allies - YSRCP and TDP - participated, Sitharaman said, "I am shocked that the Opposition doesn't want to participate. The Opposition had agreed in the BAC to debate the bill in both the Lok Sabha and the Rajya Sabha... you don't want to discuss anything, we want to have charcha."

She also said that while the Opposition often alleges that there is a need to discuss matters of public interest, it didn't participate in the discussion on a Bill which impacts a large section of society. The new law will come into force on April 1, 2026. The PM said that the Bill does not impose any new tax rate and only simplifies the language used.

Two 9-yr-old girls raped at Delhi construction site

New Delhi: Two nine-year-old girls were allegedly gang-raped late last week by two men, a contractor and a caretaker, at an under-construction swimming pool on a private property in outer Delhi's Narela. Both men have been arrested.

Police said the girls, who are neighbours, were lured to an area near the pool on some pretence. Anil Kumar (37) and Manoj Kumar (34), residents of Uttar Pradesh and Bihar, respectively, were also said to have threatened the girls after the alleged assault.

On Aug 8, the mother of

one of the survivors filed a complaint, alleging that her daughter and another girl were sexually assaulted at a swimming pool in Narela. A case was registered under sections 70CD (gang rape), 377 (wrongful confinement) and 302 (criminal intimidation) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita and sections 8 and 10 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act at Narela police station.

The statements of the survivors were recorded and they corroborated the complaint. Police arrested Anil and Manoj. Police didn't find their involvement in any previous criminal cases.
